WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL ROLLS

1. One month's notice in writing or a month's fees in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
2. Transfer Certificates are not issued until all dues of the school are paid off.
3. The security money, if not claimed in the same academic calendar, shall be treated as Donation to the school for its Development & any right over the refund of this amount stands relinquished.
4. A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue his/her studies in the school.

ATTENDANCE OF STUDENTS

Students are supposed to attend the school regularly. Prior information must be given to the concerned class-teacher for taking leave. Absentees will be dealt very strictly. If a student is absent from school without leave application for a week, his/her name shall be struck off the rolls as per Haryana School Education Rules-2003 and CBSE Bylaws. Re-admission may be granted after a payment of a fresh admission fee only at the discretion of the Principal. To appear in annual examination, a student must have 75% attendance. Students taking medical leave should submit the medical certificate alongwith fitness certificate on the day of joining after taking leave.

SCHOOL FACILITIES

Aggarwal Public School, Ballabgarh/Sector-3/Machgar take pride in providing a fantastic world class infrastructure required to run the schools as per the recommendations of CBSE.

The schools provide the facility of Auditorium, Library, Canteen, Infirmary, Art Room, Mathematics Laboratory, Social Studies Laboratory, Chemistry Laboratory, Physics Laboratory and Computer Laboratories in all the wings. All the Laboratories are well equipped with various audio-visual aids with touch of technology to fulfil the requirement for learning the subjects. A more joyful and interesting study experience is delivered to the students through learning by practical methods to make students competent enough in today's dynamic and Tech-Savvy society. The schools also provide facility of E-Learning through Smart Classes.

All class rooms and Subject-Enrichment Rooms including Art Room, Staff Rooms, Science-Labs and Computer Laboratories are well furnished and well equipped. Our auditoriums have a massive sitting capacity. With the most modern facilities and provide a stage to the students to show talent as well as to boost up their confidence.

LIBRARY

The House of Knowledge - Our library is well stocked with over 10500 titles. It caters the leading newspapers, magazines, journals, useful general and reference books. The library provides ample space for the students to browse knowledge. Experienced librarians help the students in locating their relevant books. The library is open to all bonafide students of school. All classes are provided with at least one library period per week.

Library books will be issued & returned only during library period. Books are issued for seven days at a time. Students should keep the books carefully, read them properly and must prepare reports and reviews. If the books are not returned within seven days, a fine of Rs. 2 per day will be charged.

In case of any damage done to any book by the student, double cost of the book will be charged from the student.

If a bonafide library card of any student is lost, he or she will lose the status to borrow books or periodicals from the library of the school.

However, the child can ensure his/her right or claim to avail such facility only upon renewal of library card officially. A fine of Rs. 25 (Twenty five only) will be required to be paid for the same.

SMART CLASSES

School promotes smart learning through smart classes being installed in the school campus at all levels i.e. junior level, middle level and senior level. Students are taken to smart classes regularly and taught all subjects with the prospect of making students familiar with educational technology and education - a fun and enjoyable experience.

MATHEMATICS LABORATORIES

To enable the students to have the Mathematical skills, two sophisticated Maths Labs have been established (one for Secondary classes & another for Senior Secondary classes) where students work out Mathematical formulas and theorems.

SOCIAL SCIENCE LABORATORY

To promote practical learning in social science, the school provides a laboratory in social science where students are taken regularly. The laboratory is fully equipped and well maintained with different devices and equipments related to the subject.

COMPOSITE SCIENCE LABORATORY

The school also facilitates composite science laboratory at secondary level to promote practical learning of the subject. The laboratory is equipped with all the devices where subject teachers explain the concepts to the students.

PAYMENT RULES FOR SCHOOL FEE

PAYMENT OF FEE:

1. The Cheque and Demand Draft must contain Student's name, Class, Section, Admission No. and Contact No. on the back of the cheque.
2. Date of payment is the actual date of realization of bank, parents are advised to deposit fee well in advance in case of Bank Holidays etc.
3. **All fees and funds payable to a school by a student shall be payable by the 10th day of every month**
4. A fine for the late payment of the fee and funds due shall be charged from the student at a rate of Rs. 10/- per day after 15th day of the month.
5. **The name of the student shall be struck off on the 21st day of the month or on the next working day if 21st day happens to be a holiday in case fee / funds are not deposited.**
6. Partial payment of fees is not accepted by the School and partial payment will be treated as non-payment and late fine and penalty will be applicable till the complete payment is made.
7. No fee reminders for monthly fee will be sent. It is the duty of parents to deposit the fees as per the above payment schedule.
8. Cheque returned by the bank on which it is drawn, for any reason whatsoever shall be treated as non-payment of dues and additional amount of 250/- shall be charged towards expenses along with late fine and penalty as applicable.
9. Fee timings:
Summer : 7.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon (Mon. to Sat.)
Winter : 8.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. (Mon. to Sat.)
10. Fee Receipts must be kept for full session.
11. Three months fees (January, February and March) is to be deposited together in the month of January.

1. Admission forms for classes Pre Nur. to IX are available at the school reception from the month of November.
2. Admission to classes Pre-Nur. & K.G. is given on the basis of Teacher-Child Interaction.
3. Students seeking admission in classes I to IX are required to pass a Test based on the basic knowledge of the previous class. Selection is made on the basis of performance in Test and Report Card of previous class.
4. Admission to class XI is based on Merit. Students of class X must apply for admission to class XI as soon as the result has been declared.

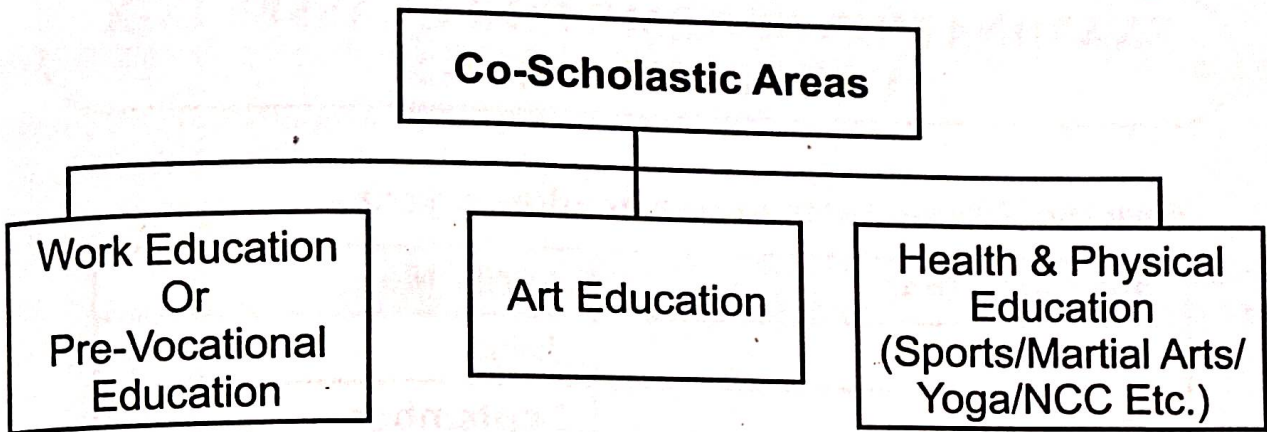
